**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will conform to those listed in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$29.00 per day for the first entry of a dog; \$24 per day for the second entry and \$19 per day for each additional entry of the same dog. Fees include AKC recording fees of \$3.50 per dog per day for the first entry and \$3 for each additional entry of the same dog. ENTRIES ON THURSDAY, FRIDAY & SATURDAY ARE UNLIMITED. SUNDAY ENTRIES LIMITED TO 145 RUNS.

**CLOSING DATE:** May 8, 2024 at 5 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

**MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS:** In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

**REFUNDS prior to close of entries:** All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$5 per run processing fee.

**REFUNDS after the close of entries:** After the close of entries, only refund requests for bitches in season can be accepted. Those requests must be received by the trial secretary within five days prior to the start of the event and no later than 1/2 hour prior to the first pulled run. Once notice is provided, the bitch in season must be removed from the trial environment. These refunds are subject to a fee of \$5 per run to cover costs incurred by the club including, but not limited to, secretarial fees and AKC fees.

### TRIAL SITE RULES & INFORMATION

- Use only the designated area to exercise your dogs.
- Please clean up after your dog(s) so that we will be considered welcomed guests at future events. We're counting on you!!
- Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be dismissed from the trial.
- Do not leave your vehicle unattended in the loading and unloading area.

No food or drink (other than water) will be allowed in the building. Parking is free and there is ample crating space. Water and indoor bathrooms are available in the building.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.**

## Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1<sup>st</sup> run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

## **CGC, CGCA, CGCU, Trick Dog and Temperament Tests**

Classic Toy Dog Club will be offering Temperament Testing on Friday, May 24, 2024 in Ring 4 following Obedience and Rally judging.

This event is only open to toy dogs.

Evaluator for these will be Jennifer Anderson of Wyoming, RI.

Fee for this test is \$25 per dog.

Classic Toy Dog Club will be offering CGC, CGCA, CGCU, Trick Dog and Temperament Testing on Saturday, May 25, 2024 in Ring 4 following Obedience and Rally judging.

Evaluator for these tests will be Samantha Satchwill of Exeter, RI.

Fee is \$25 per dog for either a CGC, Trick Dog or Temperament Test.

Entries will close each day at 12:00 Noon.

## **Fix and Go On (FNG)**

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.

Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

## **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

**TRIAL REGULATIONS -- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**THE SAFETY** of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**THE TRIAL** will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

**TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** shall not be eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries for bitches coming in season after the trial has closed. Refund requests along must be received by the trial secretary within five days of the event. Refunds are subject to all non-refundable fees incurred by the club, including but not limited to, secretarial fees and AKC recording fees.

**DOGS PARTICIPATING** must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, or be FSS breeds eligible to complete. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as trial closes. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.
